Who is this for?

CareOregon's Tribal Care Coordination Program is a service for acute health care needs of American Indian/Alaska Natives who are on fee-for-service (Open card) Oregon Health Plan. We provide extra help with health care needs beyond what you are already getting. We want to help you feel strong and healthy again.

If you have a serious or chronic health condition or disease, or if you are disabled, we have a team of professionals that are ready to help you.

Conditions such as:

- Diabetes
- Heart failure
- Asthma
- Depression
- Substance abuse
(drugs, alcohol or tobacco, etc)

And more...

We work together with Oregon's nine federally recognized Tribes and the Native American Rehabilitation Association of the Northwest. Care coordination is free and voluntary, individually driven and designed to complement existing services.

What's in this program?

Our trained staff at CareOregon coordinates care among your doctors, other providers, home and community support agencies and social service organizations.

We can help you:

Find a provider for any of your special health care needs, including mental health and substance abuse issues

Get appointments with primary care providers, specialists or other health care or behavioral health providers

Get rides to appointments

Get needed medical equipment, supplies or services

Our team of nurses, behavioral health specialists and health care coordinators will help you understand treatment plans set by your primary care provider. We can also help make the most of provider visits and connect you with other helpful resources in your community.
