

CareOregon Model of Care (MOC) Training

Frequently Asked Questions

Q: Who is required to take the Model of Care (MOC) Training?

A: All providers who see or treat CareOregon Advantage members are required to take MOC training. Per CMS, providers only need to complete the training once per MOC cycle. CareOregon's current MOC is approved for CY2026-2028.

Q: Can one attestation be submitted on behalf of an organization?

A: Yes. By attesting on behalf of the organization, the submitter is confirming the required training has been completed by all affiliated providers who see or treat CareOregon Advantage members. Attestations can be submitted using this link: [2026 CareOregon Training Attestation](#).

Q: Can we submit the attestation before December 31, 2026?

A: Yes. The training should be completed, and the attestation should be submitted **on or before** December 31, 2026.

Q: Do we have to complete CareOregon's MOC training if we already have our own or have completed a similar one through another approved entity/organization?

A: Not necessarily. Other plans' MOC training can be substituted for the COA-specific training. You will need to submit a copy of the proposed training materials by attaching them to the [2026 CareOregon Training Attestation](#) form. A CareOregon representative will review the training and reach out to let you know if it is **not** an allowable substitute.
