REMEMBER:

- IF BREATHING HAS STOPPED, PERFORM RESCUE BREATHING.
- · WAIT WITH THE PERSON UNTIL HELP ARRIVES.
- . IF YOU MUST LEAVE, TURN THE PERSON ON THEIR SIDE SO THAT THEY DON'T CHOKE TO DEATH.
- · NEVER USE ALONE.



WE'LL GIVE HER SOME NARCAN IN THE AMBULANCE, THAT'LL BRING HER AROUND.


> IF IT WEREN'T FOR YOU, SHE'D PROBABLY BE DEAD NOW.



REMEMBER:

- · MIXING BENZOS, OPIATES OR NARCOTIC PAINKILLERS AND ALCOHOL CAN BE DEADLY.
- · CALL 911. IF YOU KNOW WHAT DRUGS THE PERSON WAS TAKING, TELL THEM.
- TO PERFORM RESCUE BREATHING:
 - MAKE SURE NOTHING IS IN MOUTH.
 - TILT HEAD BACK, LIFT CHIN AND PINCH NOSE.
 - DO TWO QUICK BREATHS. MAKE SURE
 - THEN BREATHE IN EVERY FIVE SECONDS.
 - MAKE SURE CHEST RISES AFTER EACH BREATH.







REMEMBER:

- AN OVERDOSE IS MORE LIKELY TO OCCUR WHEN SOMEONE HASN'T BEEN USING IN A WHILE.
- · CALL 911 AND TELL THEM IT'S AN OVERDOSE OR THAT THE PERSON WILL NOT WAKE UP.
- · IF BREATHING HAS STOPPED, PERFORM RESCUE BREATHING.

- PERSON WON'T WAKE UP, EVEN TO YELLING THEIR NAME, OR RUBBING HARD ON THEIR BREASTBONE
- CLAMMY, COOL SKIN
- BLUE LIPS OR FINGERNAILS

REMEMBER:

- MIXING HEROIN AND PILLS AND ALCOHOL CAN BE DEADLY.
- · LOOK, LISTEN, AND FEEL TO SEE IF PERSON IS BREATHING.
- CALL 911.
- IF THE PERSON IS NOT BREATHING, PERFORM RESCUE BREATHING.
- · ADMINISTER NARCAN, IF YOU HAVE IT. (SEE BACK COVER FOR INFORMATION ABOUT FREE NARCAN.)
- IF YOU CAN, TELL PARAMEDICS ABOUT ANY SUBSTANCES THE PERSON HAS BEEN USING.
